LIBRARY RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Strict Silence should be observed in the library.
2. Personal belonging such as Bags, Tiffin-boxes, Notebooks, etc., should be left at the property counter in the library entrance.
3. Books are lent to students on all working days.
4. Books are usually lent for a period of fifteen days and may be renewed for a further period if those books are not in demand by other students.
5. Books should be returned on or before the due date indicate in the issue slip of the book.
6. Overdue fine of Rs.1 per day will be charged if the book is not returned on time.
7. Students must bring their ID card and library token at the time of borrowing books.
8. Personal books, Library books already issued, notebooks etc. should not to be taken inside the library. Only loose sheets are allowed inside.
9. SILENCE & CLEANLINESS should be strictly maintained in & around the Library.
10. Do not tear pages from the books.
11. Books and Periodicals should be replaced in proper places after reading.
12. Within the stipulated period, the books have to be either returned back or further be extended.
13. Borrower's tickets are not transferable.

14. If the due date falls on holidays, return can be done on the following working day without fine.
15. Reference books such as Dictionaries, Year Books, Journals, Projects reports, Textbooks with a marking reference etc., Will not be issued.
16. All the books should be returned before the examination.
17. Books are to be handled very carefully. If a book is lost by the student, she shall replace the book (same title, author and edition) or shall pay double the cost of the book as fine.
18. Students are not allowed to enter the library, during the class hours.
19. Any marking or writing in the book is strictly prohibited.
20. Mobile phones may not be used inside the library.
